The Bell Waltham St Lawrence

A traditional village inn that provides a very real service to the local community and beyond is the ethos behind The Bell Inn at Waltham St Lawrence.

First and foremost a real ale pub, the free house serves up traditional ales on hand pump which change daily including guest ales such as Black Swan Mild, Hoppit and their regular Waltham St Lawrence No.1 Bitter for true beer connoisseurs.

The stunning building is a 'Wealden' house which is Grade II listed and boasts a wealth of history, much of which has been retained.

Run by brothers Iain and Scott for nearly two years, they pride themselves on the high standard of catering. Customers call in for a pint while the food offers a real surprise element. With no reservations taken, the food simply speaks for itself, offering a real wow factor.

Literally everything is freshly prepared and cooked on the premises - they even make up their own ketchup and stocks.

Many of the dishes are traditional fayre with an added twist to give them a contemporary edge. The team is passionate about their work and the excellent chefs are given the time and space to experiment with unique ingredients and flavours - and they deliver time and again.

Dishes change on a daily basis, depending on the season and the produce available. Examples include guinea fowl roasted in star anise and cinnamon, slow cooked until the meat literally falls off the bone or braised lentils.

Snacks and sandwiches are also available with food served inside for up to 50 people while the garden can cater for up to 70 guests.

Priding themselves on the quality of their food and ale, the pub was a deserved winner of the CAMRA Best

pub award for 2003 and 2004 and has since gone from strength to strength.

Having built up both a loyal local following as well as guests visiting from some distance for the hospitality, together with the flavours and aromas that emerge from the kitchen, The Bell is leading the way in pub dining today.
